CHAPTER V

5.2 Suggestion

- b) The English teachers should combine the Wordwall Game with other teaching strategies to help the students improve their English.

3. For the Further Researchers

- a) The further researchers it is hoped that this research can be useful and be more used as a useful reference for developing effective technology learning media used in students' mastery in writing class.
- b) For further researchers, I hope that this study can encourage them to find new techniques, strategies, or media to teach writing and improve students' writing skills.
