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ABSTRACT

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ABSTRACT: The aim of this research is to reveal the ethical dilemmas and risks of using artificial intelligence language models in student writing. This research used qualitative method. The data for this study was collected through a survey on the forum and collected data from 25 people and 10 student essays. The survey uses open-ended questions to collect qualitative insights. The questionnaire be structured to first collect demographic information. The results of this study found that on average, students who worked on essays and filled out surveys experienced and faced different ethical risks and dilemmas. The results showed that of the 25 students who voted 123 votes in the questionnaire and in ethical issues indicated by plagiarism, concerns about data leakage, and lack of originality, then excessive reliance on the use of artificial intelligence. It can be stated that artificial intelligence is extremely risky to utilize because to the difficulties in thinking and creativity, slowly decreasing the quality of writers.
