

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

This chapter presents the conclusion from the research that was conducted, which is based on the results and the research question of the research topic. In addition, in this section, the suggestions for the readers and the further researchers who want to do the same research will be discussed briefly.

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

The research is about conversation analysis of adjacency pairs in a podcast video hosted by Deddy Corbuzier and the Palestine Ambassador as the guest. There are two research objectives in this research, namely, to identify the types of adjacency pairs in the podcast video and to find out the implications of the types of adjacency pairs towards the conversation. Then, the researcher concluded the results as follows:

1. In the podcast video, there are five types of adjacency pair that appear between the participants in the conversation. They are greeting-greeting which is 1 pair (1,35%), complement-acceptance which is 4 pairs (5, 41%), assessment-agreement which is 1 pair (1,35%), question-expected answer which is 62 pairs (83, 78%), question unexpected-answer which is 5 pairs (6, 76%) and leave-taking adjacency pair which is 1 pair (1,35%). The question-answer is the most dominant type that appears in the conversation between the participants.
2. The implication of the types of adjacency pairs towards the conversation in the podcast video is that the adjacency pair that used by Deddy Corbuzier and the Palestine ambassador Dr. Zuhair Al-Shun shapes effective communication, where the response of the participants are mostly an appropriate response to the questions, compliments, and others, so the viewers or listeners can understand the topic that is discussed between the participants in the conversation.

## **5.2 Suggestion**

Based on the conclusion of the research, the researcher suggests some suggestions for the readers and the further researchers:

1. For the readers: It is hoped that this research can be useful as a reference to add insight and a deeper understanding of conversation analysis, especially in adjacency pair aspect.
2. For the future researchers: Since this research used a video podcast, it is hoped that further researchers will use the other objects, or it that will be more interesting for the further researchers to examine the other aspects of conversation analysis.
