#### ABSTRACT

#### PRONUNCIATION ERRORS MADE BY INDONESIAN SINGERS

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The purposes of this research is to identify the types and to know factors causing pronunciation errors. Data are taken from English cover songs by Indah Yastami and Via Vallen on their YouTube channels. The method of this research is a qualitative research method, and the research design is a case study. Observation and library research are data collection techniques for this research to identify words, classify types and factors causing pronunciation errors. The researcher uses the theory of types of pronunciation errors by Dulay et al. (1982) and the theory of factors causing pronunciation errors by O'Connor (2003). The results of this study showed that the researcher found a total of 18 errors from 16 words containing errors. Then the errors are identified into four types, namely omission (22.22%), addition (16.67%), misformation (55.56%) and misordering (5.55%). Through this research misformation is the most errors type that is used. Factors causing pronunciation errors that is mostly use is Inconsistency of English Vowels. Pronunciation error is the action or habit of pronouncing a word in a way that is considered inappropriate or incorrect due to a lack of knowledge. Futhermore, Pronunciation is one of elements in speaking skill which is truly important to make the communication run well.
