1.1 Background of The Research

A SMK or Vocational High School, is a formal educational setting that organizes vocational education at the secondary level as a continuation of junior high schools, or MTs, or other equivalent or advanced forms of learning outcomes that are recognized as equal to junior high schools, or MTS. SMK differs from SMA in that, whereas SMA focuses on preparing students for the next level of study (college), SMK focuses on preparing students for the workforce. Tourism is one of the majors available at SMK in Kuningan.

To help students solve their challenges, the teacher should motivate develop an effective strategy to stimulate their interest in improving their

speaking skills. Because utterance will not occur unless the speaker is brave and confident in himself or herself, self-confidence is essential in speaking ability.

Cooperative learning is an active learning process because students learn more by creating and sharing knowledge in groups. Cooperative learning can provide students with the opportunity of discussion and help students develop essential social skills (Khan & Inamullah, 2011). Cooperative learning is a method used by educators that can help students to develop necessary social skills. Healthy interaction skills, the success of the individual student and group members, and the formation of personal and professional relationships are the results of cooperative learning (Johnson & Johnson, 1999). Cooperation is important because science teachers attempt to teach students more learning materials in a culturally and linguistically diverse classroom, and in a comprehensive classroom environment (Doran, Doran, & Mazur, 2011).

The STAD method which is known as the Student Team Achievement Division designed by (Slavin R. E., 1994) is one of the most prominent among 10 cooperative learning methods. STAD is one of Cooperative Learning strategies that help promote learning skills of cooperation and self-controlment (Rai & Samsuddin, 2007). According to (Armstrong, Palmer, & Jesse, 2014) in STAD technique students are assigned to four or five members team reflecting a heterogeneous grouping of high, average, and low achieving students of diverse ethnic backgrounds and different genders. As in the entire cooperative learning models to follow, STAD operates on the principle that student works together to learn and are responsible for their teammate's learning as well as their own (Hassard

& Dias, 2008). (Slavin R. E., Cooperative Learning, 1980) defined this model as an effective learning method in a class circumstance that students carry out learning activities as a team and receive rewards and recognitions based on their team scores.

Teacher can use some techniques or activities to help students active and motivated in acquiring the speaking ability based on the instructional material given. In this study, the researcher uses Student Teams Achievement Division (STAD) as the technique. In this technique students can share their problem or difficulties with their friends in group. So, group work will limit their doubt, fearful, and feeling shy to speak and to express their opinion. The group consist of different background, included smart children. Therefore, each student will more confident to speak in group than to speak in front of the entire friend.

This research focuses how affect students' speaking skill by using Student Team Achievement (STAD) is better and effective. Besides the object of this research focuses in vocational school, it is no doubt Student Team Achievement Division (STAD) provide opportunities for the students to learn speaking English and bring new experience for students. Thus, this research is conduct to affect students' speaking skill by using Student Team Achievement Division (STAD).
